**WHEREAS**, the Board has received and considered public comment and Board comment on the Proposed Rules and Regulations; and

**WHEREAS,** the Board held a public hearing on the Proposed Rules and Regulations, on September 19, 2019 at 6:00 pm in the Sullivan Community Hall in Seeley Lake;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Seeley Lake-Missoula County Sewer District Board of Directors adopt the Seeley Lake Sewer District Rules and Regulations- dated 8-15-2019 as amended on October 17, 2019; and November 21, 2019, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Board authorizes any necessary typographical or formatting corrections to the Rules and Regulations as they were proposed and adopted.
